# Bug Tracker

We use [JIRA](#) <sup>[3]</sup> to track ROOT bugs and to gather feature requests.

Anyone can add a new bug, comment on an existing bug, or even submit a patch to fix a bug. You will need to create a [CERN lightweight account](#) <sup>[4]</sup> (or use your existing CERN account) and use it to log into JIRA to submit new bugs or post comments on existing bugs.

If you are new to using JIRA or have not submitted bugs for ROOT, here are a few things you might want to read:
